Quatenam est tempestas hodie? – How is the weather today?

Videamus quatenam sit tempestas hodie! – Let's see how the weather is today!

Sol lucet. - The sun is shining.

Sol vehementer lucet. – The sun is really shining.

Sol splendide lucet.- The sun is shining bright.

Sol plerumque lucet. - The sun's shining for the most part.

Est vix unus nimbus in caelo. – There's barely a cloud in the sky.

Apollo currum agit manifeste per caelum. - Apollo is driving his sun-chariot clear across the sky. (a very sunny day)

Caelum est plerumque serenum. - The sky is mostly clear.

Quam bellus dies! - What a pretty day!

Ver adest! - Spring is here!

Est tam caldus quam furnus. – It's as hot as an oven.

Aridum et percaldum est. – It's dry and very hot.

Aestuosum est. - It's boiling hot.

Pluit. - It's raining.

Pluit paullulum. - It's raining just a little bit (drizzle).

Imbres praedicant. - They're calling for rain.

Caelum est nubilum. - The sky is cloudy.

Ventosum est. – It's windy.

Ventosum et madidum est. - It's windy and wet.

Sunt fulgores et tonitrua frequentia. – There's lots of thunder and lightning.

Ningit. - It's snowing.

Tempestas frigida est. - It's cold weather.

ut fit hieme (aestate) (his temporibus anni) - as happens in the winter (summer) (this time of year)

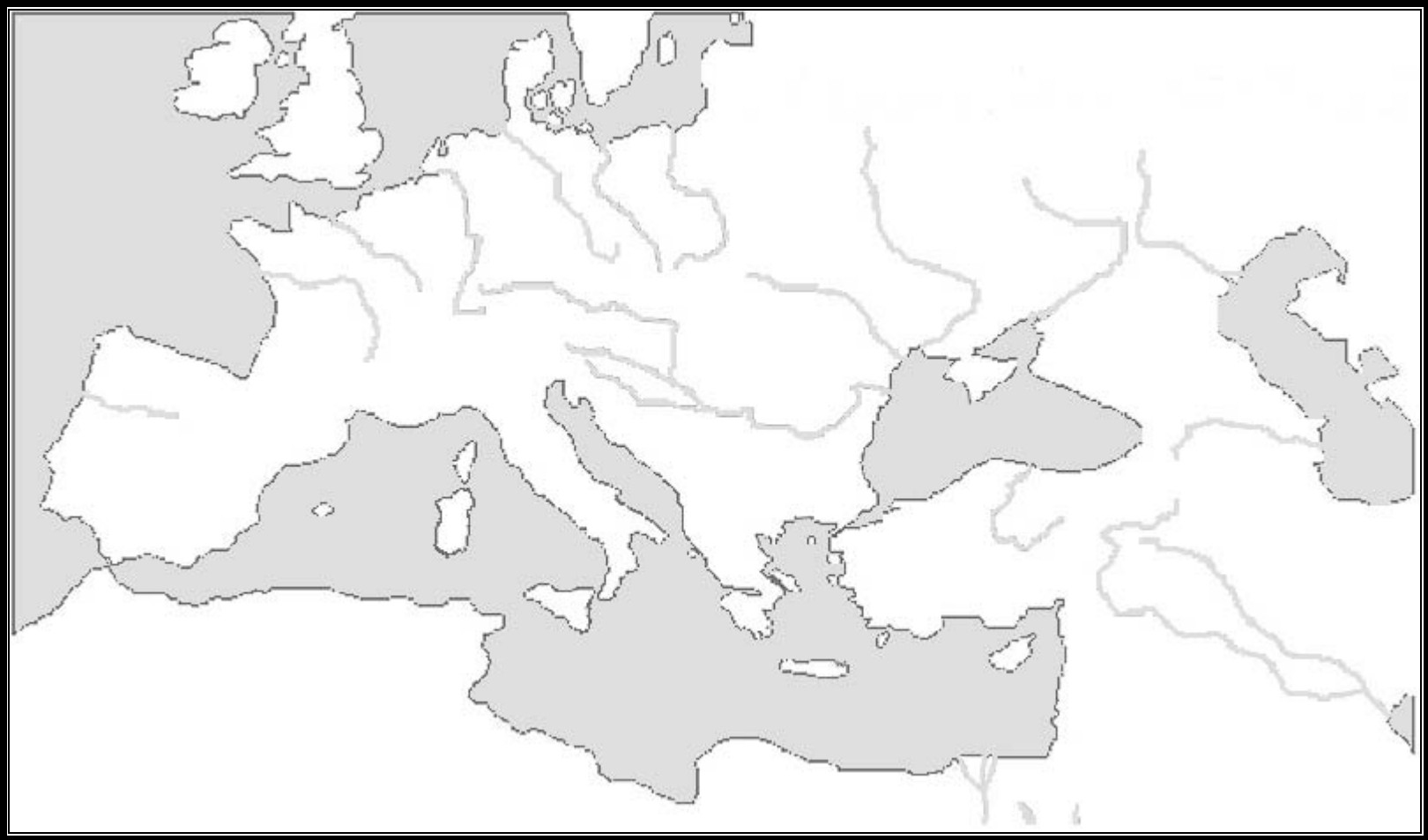

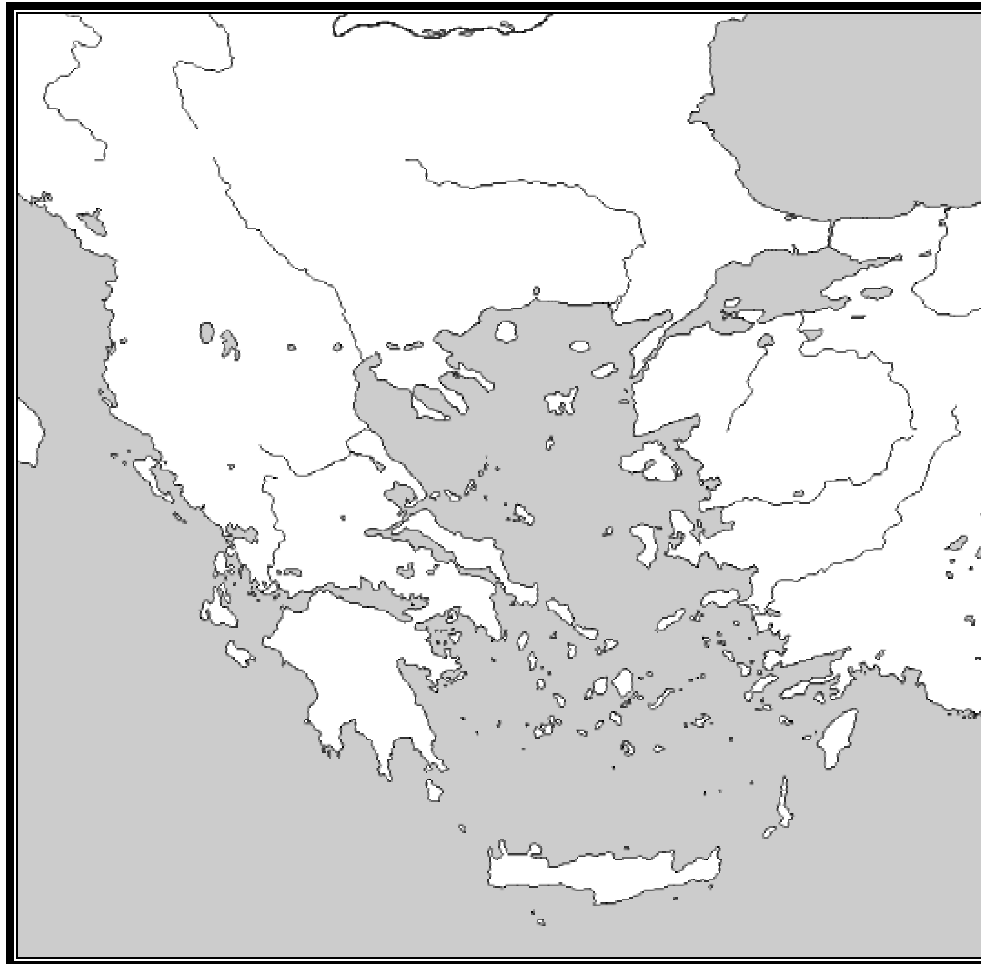
