
The National Latin Exam welcomes the participation of homeschoolers. Homeschool teachers should follow the standard application process, with slight variations. (See below.) Print out an application from our website, www.nle.org. If you have trouble printing out an application, e-mail the NLE office, nle@umw.edu and we will gladly send you an application. Please include your mailing address in your e-mail message.

Fill in the application completely. Be sure to specify that your school is a home school, and please provide the teacher's phone number. Make sure to specify how many and which levels of the exam(s) you are requesting.

***The homeschool teacher or parent **MUST** make arrangements for someone other than the Latin teacher to administer the exam. The exam administrator can be the other parent, a neighbor, etc., so long as that person doesn't help the student(s) taking the exam. We make this stipulation to protect the integrity of the exam. Homeschool teachers should place the exam administrator's name both on the line of the application that requests that information and on the line that asks for the principal's name.*
